INTRODUCED GRASSES

Grasses have been introduced to Australia for pasture, horticulture, and accidentally.

Most are uncommon in intact vegetation but invade disturbed areas strongly, and can severely hamper revegetation efforts.

Pampas grass and Kikuyu have been featured on earlier posters in this series.

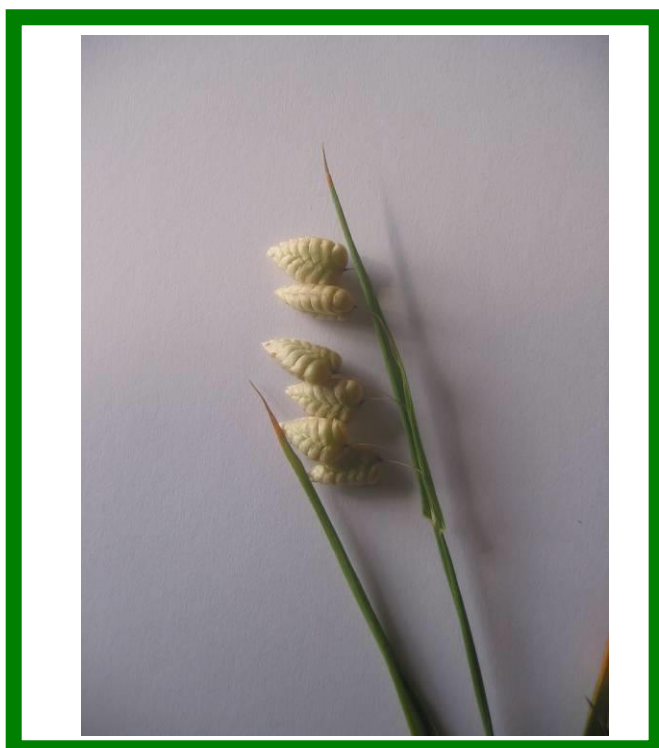

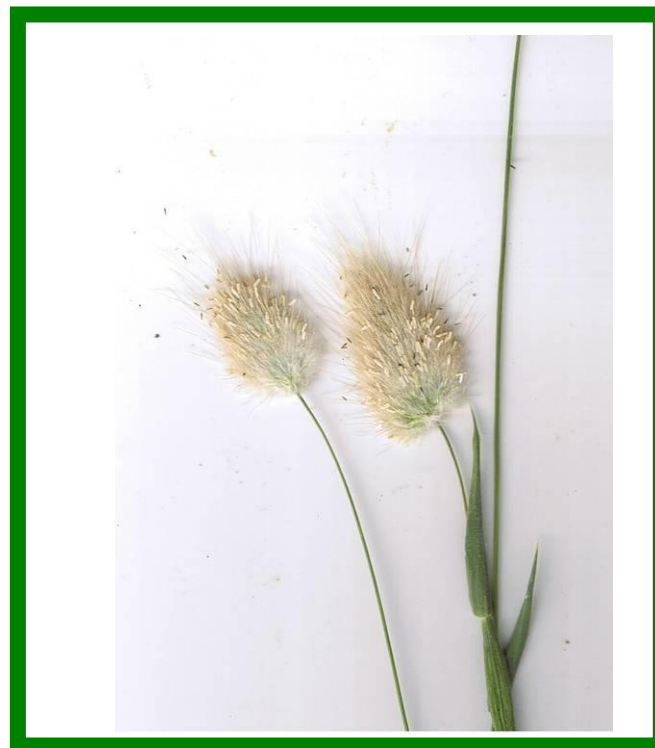
